Monday July 15th

First part commenced with a gale breeze from the S.W. cruising employed in breaking out water middle and latter part same sundown took in sail and ran on high in sight midnight rain same save all this day & night

Tuesday July 16th

Long 91 39 E

First part commenced with a moderate breeze from the S.W. cruising saw blackish humpbacks employed in breaking out provisions middle and latter part rain light two sails cantan and S. A. small sundown took in sail midnight rain light so ends the day

Wednesday July 17th

First part commenced with a light rain from the S.W. cruising employed in ship's water middle and latter part rain the same at seven P.M. part came from high S. A. small half past five meat back sundown took in sail at midnight rain same so ends this day

Thursday July 18th

First part commenced with a light rain from S.W. at daylight saw a small school of large whales going to the W. made all sail and steered to the W. cantan and ship in sight got ready to lower middle part whales six miles off bearing W. S.W. latter part saw them again at seven P.M. whales headed off W. E. at dark about three miles bearing of W. slow took in sails and laced to midnight rain light so ends this day

Friday July 19th

First part commenced with a gale breeze from the S.W. lying a back at seven P.M. made sail put off at seven P.M. hauled to the S.W. at half past eight saw a large school of whales marking to the S.W. at ten P.M. lowered starboard part went in a large whale whale saw the boat and stone a whale in her did not strike whales went to in incline took in sail and gave ahead to her part struck a small ball mast boat came up and struck a large one whales went off to the S.W. middle part rain light at half past three but them a long side got ready and hauled in at half past five got the small land in got supper and set three watches so ends this day

First part commenced with a light rain from S.W. employed in hailing middle and latter part same saw blackish midnight rain light so ends this day
