First part commenced with a light breeze from the NWSW heading at daylight same employed in ships duties middle and latter part same sundown same light midnight same so ends this day

First part commenced with a light breeze from the S heading S E employed in ships duties saw blackish middle and latter part same of five saw a whale going to windward called him a humpback midnight same light so ends this day

First part commenced with a light breeze from the S heading S E at daylight same employed in ships duties middle and latter part same hauled and headed W wind SWS sundown gale breeze midnight rain light so ends this day

First part commenced with a light breeze from the SWS heading W daylight same nothing doing middle and latter part same breeze sundown same midnight rain light so ends this day

First part commenced with a strong breeze from the S steering WSW employed in ships duties middle and latter part same took in staysails and got the sail in daylight same so ends this day

First part commenced with a strong breeze from the S E steering WSW employed in ships duties middle and latter part same saw a large breach at midnight same so ends this day
Lat 11° 15' S Long 21° 00' E

Saturday Aug 31st

First part commenced with a strong breeze from the S E and cloudy steering WSW employed in ships duties middle and latter part same the same sundown took in to lower topsails and hauled to the wind midnight same the same so ends this day

Sunday Sept 1st

First part commenced with a strong breeze from the S E at daylight same at eight o'clock set topsails & steered W SWS nothing doing middle and latter part same sundown Charleses sail midnight rain strong so ends this day

First part commenced with a fresh breeze from the S E at daylight same at eight o'clock put up the W by N employed in setting up head stays middle and latter part same same at five P.M. hauled on the wire at midnight same the same so ends this day
