midnight calm so ends this day

First part commenced with a gale breeze from S
employed in part duties same watch on shore
middle and latter part same midnight rain
so ends this day

Friday Sept 20th

First part commenced with a fresh breeze from the
S E and watch on liberty employed in part duties
middle and latter part same midnight strong
rain so ends this day

Saturday Sept 21st

First part commenced with a fresh breeze from S E
and watch on liberty employed in part duties middle
and latter part same midnight light rain so ends this day

Sunday Sept 22nd

First part commenced with a fresh breeze from S E
and watch on a run with day two men missing since
Friday Charles walked huts to rear and George
saw and habs middle and latter part fresh
breezes and equally midnight same so ends this
day

deserted with

short frame the lower full bolt broke put in another
and hove up at two P M went to sea latter part stored
chairs and a couple of decks sundown steering W by N
James town harbor hearing E by S dist 2 miles at
midnight gale breeze so ends this day

Wednesday Sept 25th

First part commenced with a gale breeze from the S E steering
W by N day light squalls of rain employed in repainting
ship's middle and latter part same four P M
finished recut it and wind moderate at
midnight same so ends this day

Thursday Sept 26th

First part commenced with a gale breeze from S E steering
W by N all sail set daylight took the sparker down to
repair middle and latter part same at four finished
and hove it sundown hauled W midnight same light
so ends this day

Friday Sept 27th

First part commenced with a gale breeze from the S E
steering W by N at daylight squalls of rain at
ten P M sent another jib middle and latter
part same sundown light squalls of rain
midnight same so ends this day

Saturday Sept 28th

First part commenced with a gale breeze from the
S E steering W all sail set daylight rain
same employed in ship's clothes middle and
latter part same sundown gale breeze midnight
same so ends this day
