Sunday Dec 22nd

First part commenced with a gale breeze from the N at three o'clock rain hauled out daylight strong breeze made sail and put off at E in company with sun seen middle and latter part rain same three put off at sundown took in sail and hauled on the wind to the SE midnight rain same so ends this day Lat 37.20 S Long 46.40 W

Monday Dec 23rd

First part commenced with fresh breeze from S at daylight same employed in ship's duties middle and latter part rain same sundown took in sail midnight fresh breeze so ends this day Lat 36.40 S Long 46.40 W

Tuesday Dec 24th

First part commenced with a gale breeze from the SE at daylight rain same employed in ship's duties middle and latter part rain SE at sundown took in sail at midnight rain same so ends this day Lat 37.19 S Long 47.16 W

Wednesday Dec 25th

First part commenced with a strong breeze from the SE at daylight made sail employed in ship's duties middle and latter part rain same sundown took in sail midnight rain at sundown this day Lat 37.32 S Long 47.00 W

Thursday Dec 26th

First part commenced with a fresh breeze from the SE at daylight thick employed in ship's duties middle and latter part rain at fair both headed to the E sundown thick thick midnight same so ends this day Lat 37.07 S Long 47.00 W

First part commenced with a light rain from the SW at daylight made sail and put off at E employed in ship's duties middle and latter part rain same at sundown took in sail hauled to the SE midnight rain light so ends this day Lat 37.00 S Long 47.00 W

Sunday Dec 29th

First part commenced with a light rain from the W at daylight rain hauled SE made sail headed SE at three o'clock rain hauled NE middle and latter part rain same sundown took in sail midnight rain light so ends this day Lat 36.30 S Long 46.40 W

Monday Dec 30th

First part commenced with a light rain from the SE at daylight set off sail at three o'clock employed in repairing the fore topsail middle and latter part rain same at three o'clock topsail sundown took in sail and headed to SE midnight rain same so ends this day Lat 36.35 S Long 46.39 W

Tuesday Dec 31st

First part commenced with a light rain from the SW at daylight made sail and put off at E at daylight at three o'clock the upper fore topsail hauled to repair middle and latter part rain light at fair both sent up topsail sundown calm took in sail at midnight rain light from SE headed to SE so ends this day Lat 35.52 S Long 45.55 W
