

Remarks On Board Bark *Platina*Wednesday Jan 1st

First part commences with a moderate breeze from the *W* at daylight made sail & *W* employed in ships duties middle and latter part rain some sundown took in sail hauled on the main midnight rain light so ends this day Lat 36° 03' Long 45° 50' W

Thursday Jan 2nd

First part commences with a gale breeze from *W* heading *W* at daylight made sail & *W* employed in clearing topsails & riggers middle and latter part rain some sundown took in sail midnight rain light so ends this day Lat 36° 34' S Long 46° 24' W

Friday Jan 3rd

First part commences with a strong breeze from the *W* at daylight rain same set foresail and *W* employed in ships duties middle and latter part rain some *W* saw a hawk heading to the *E* midnight rain same so ends this day Lat 37° 10' S Long 46° 50' W

Saturday Jan 4th

First part commences with a fresh breeze from *W* with rain at one *E* at rain hauled out *E* & took in main topsail daylight rain same middle part put up *W* & *W* set main topsail latter part rain some sundown hauled to the *E* midnight rain same so ends this day Lat 37° 51' S Long 47° 00' W

Sunday Jan 5th

First part commences with a moderate gale breeze from the *E* with rain daylight same took in main topsails middle part breeze up hauled to the *S* latter part still raining sundown no change midnight blow heading with rain so ends this day Lat 38° 00' S Long 47° 00' W

Monday Jan 6th

First part commences with a gale breeze from *S* & *E* at three *E* at rain hauled out *W* and *E* at daylight rain light at seven *E* at rain breeze up from the *S* & *E* a fresh middle part moderate sundown rain light from the *W* midnight rain hauled *E* & *W* moderate so ends this day Lat 36° 58' S Long 48° 49' W

Tuesday Jan 7th

First part commences with a strong breeze from the *SW* daylight made sail put off *W* & *E* employed in putting new bolts in main top middle and latter part rain some sundown took in sail hauled to the *S* midnight rain moderate so ends this day Lat 35° 58' S Long 48° 02' W

Wednesday Jan 8th

First part commences with a strong breeze from *SW* daylight made sail hauled *W* & *E* employed in ships duties middle and latter part rain some sundown took in sail midnight rain same so ends this day Lat 35° 50' S Long 46° 23' W

Thursday Jan 9th

First part commences with a gale breeze from the *W* heading *E* & *E* daylight made sail employed in ships duties middle part moderate made ship heads *W* & *W* latter part rain light sundown took in sail heading *W* & *W* at *E* midnight rain same so ends this day Lat 35° 08' S Long 45° 54' W

Friday Jan 10th

First part commences with a gale breeze from the *W* heading *W* at daylight made sail rain *W* & *E* employed in ships duties middle part headed to *E* & *E* at six *E* took in sail came an equally rain hauled out *E* & headed to the *S* midnight rain moderate undressed aft so ends this day Lat 35° 30' S Long 46° 19' W

Saturday Jan 11th

First part commences with a gale breeze from *E* & *E* heading *N* & *E* daylight made sail employed in ships duties middle and latter part rain some sundown took in sail midnight rain light so ends this day Lat 34° 12' S Long 46° 37' W

Sunday Jan 12th

First part commences with a moderate breeze from the *E* daylight made sail nothing doing middle part headed to *S* & *E* latter part light rain sundown took in sail midnight rain light so ends this day Lat 34° 22' S Long 46° 26' W
