Remarks Tuesday July 1st 1890

Came in with very light S.E. Wind & Pleasant Weather on Starboard Tack under all sail employed Painter & Stork Boat and other light jobs at sunset Tacked ship to Starboard & W. Shortened sail middle & latter part of at & sunset daylight a sail in sight on lee Bow - Browned to be Berk Berk George & Mary Foster ten years out 10. app. George & Mary 15 days from Dominica taken nothing lately

Long 49.18. West

Wednesday July 2nd Long 49.18. West
Commenced with a light Wind, S.E. to E. & S.E. and Pleasant Weather under all sail on Western Tack Gunning George and Mary sunset shortened sail 10.30 through middle and latter part went out same at 5.00
Went ship set all sail on S.B. Tack Brock out
Bark flour twenty Bags to use Berk George & Mary in sight
Lat. 29.42. North

Thursday July 3rd Long 49.35. West
Commenced with light S.E. Wind and Pleasant Weather in S.B. Tack under all sail at 6.00
A.M. Gained Berk George & Mary at 10.30 through
hauled hke sail middle and latter at 6.00
P.M. set all sail Tack ship to S.B. Wind & set
sail Berk in sight Weather Bree & quarter
29.37. Lat. 29.44. North

Friday July 4th Long 49.45. West
Commenced with light S.E. Wind and Pleasant Weather on Port Tack under all possible sail
sail Berk in sight to Weather Bree same Tack
sunset shortened sail hauled light sails courses middle
& latter went out same set all sail at 6. P.M. on Port
Tack employed Broke back back Berk George
& Mary in sight to Windward.

Bark Mastina in Bedford Captain Giles P. Bledsoe master
Remarks Sunday July 5th 1890

Commenced with light Wind from E. By 10.00 to Pleasant
on Port Tack until sunset Tack under all possible
sail heading S.W. sail Berk in sight middle &
latter part went out at 6.30 set all possible
sail on S.B. Tack in sight Steamer Stirling
& Ward Big rig
Lat. 29.35. North

Sunday July 6th Long 49.48. West
Commenced with light E. S.E. Wind and Pleasant
Weather Tack ship to S.E. at 2.30 A.M.
Berk George and Mary in sight lee Bow Gained
her at sunset until 10. A.M. middle & latter
part went out the same set all Lat. 29.40. North
sail at 6.00 P.M. Warship with N.E. 49.44. N
employed crimping Bulwarks & masts getting ready
to Paint Berk George & Mary in sight on S.B. Tack
Tack

Monday July 7th
Commenced with very light E.N.E. Wind & Weather
Pleasant at sunset went ship to S.E. hauled
light sails middle showery latter light Wind Pleasant
on Port Tack under topsails courses heading S.E. & S.E.
employed Bucking out ship stores as Buf Bread sugar
Put new masts coats to mizen & main mast
took down Boat Potatoes on Stow away Blow
other light jobs
Lat. 29.50. North

Tuesday July 8th Long 50.09. West
Commenced with very light Wind and hauled to the
South mol. to W. War ship at sunset shortened sail
heading to the South on S.B. Tack latter part
Wind hauling to W.N.W. employed Paint
Bulwarks and rails in side four claves to the
deck latter part Wind North most a calm
Lat. 29.50. North
Long 50.00 West
