

Ship Plover, of New Bedford, in Geography.

Sunday, February 10th 1861

Anchored. Land with light baffling winds under all sail at 1 P.M. passed the Cape. at 4 P.M. boarded the Barque Barnstable, of New Bedford. Brought Master & man the out 85 barrels of sperm Oil. at 5. let go the Anchor off Tail Rock in 10 fathoms of water, and furled the sails, at 8 P.M. got under way, and made all sail. So Ends.
B. Barnstable beating up to the tub, saw three sails at Anchor

Monday, February 11th 1861

Painting. Land with a light breeze from the S.W. and fine weather under all sail heading in for the tub. at 3 P.M. let go the Anchor in 10 fathoms of water, at 7 P.M. un-bent all the sails and went to painting the spars. & sent a raft of caskson shore. So Ends with a strong breeze from S.E.

Tuesday, February 13th 1861

Watering. Land with a strong breeze from S.E. and quite Painting. rugged employed in watering & painting, latter part strong breeze from the S.W. So Ends. Painting and cleaning ship.

Wednesday, February 15th 1861

Painting. Land with a brisk wind from the S.W. middle and latter parts moderate, employed in watering and painting Larboard side.

Thursday, February 16th 1861

Watering. All these 24 hours light pleasant weather, painting, watering & breaking out. So Ends.

Friday, February 17th 1861

Painting &c. All these 24 hours light pleasant weather, painting &c. So Ends.

Saturday, February 18th 1861

Painting &c. All these 24 hours brisk breeze from E. W. finish watering & painting spars. So Ends.

Sunday, February 17th 1861

All sorts. All these 24 hours strong wind from the S.W. to N.W. Employed in various sorts, So Ends.

Monday, February 18th 1861

Potatoes. All these 24 hours brisk winds from the S.E. &c. Employed in getting off Potatoes, So Ends.

Tuesday, February 19th 1861

Liberty. All these 24 fresh breezes from S.W. doing nothing to speak of. sent the watch on liberty, So Ends.

Wednesday, February 20th 1861

Liberty. All these 24 hours fresh breezes from S.E. to S.W. Employed in getting woods the watch on liberty, sent an shore a barrel of fish.

Thursday, February 21st 1861

Liberty. Land with fresh breezes from S.E. latter part light winds from S.W. the watch on liberty, So Ends.

Friday, February 22nd 1861

Deserted. All these 24 hours light pleasant weather the watch on liberty the other painting inside Thomas Ryan & William Henry Spotten Deserted

Saturday, February 23rd 1861

Liberty. All these 24 hours light pleasant weather, one watch on liberty, the other painting inside.

Sunday, February 24th 1861

Liberty. All these 24 hours light weather painting inside So Ends. on liberty.

Monday, February 25th 1861

Liberty. All these 24 hours light pleasant weather, So Ends. finished painting inside, on liberty.

Tuesday, February 26th 1861

Deserted. All these 24 hours pleasant weather one watch employed in various sorts, the other on liberty, George Augubine Deserted, So Ends. sent an shore a barrel of fish.
