 wore ship to the S. E. repaired the Old
 Fore Sail & bent the New one. So Ends
 Lat 19. 49. S. Long 61. 16. E.

Blk. Peris.
 Friday, July 26th 1861
 Begins with strong trade heading to the
 N. E. under short sail, at 8. P. M. spoke the
 Bark *Peris*, of New Bedford, Norton, Master,
 14 months out 25 Mbls. V. at sunset shortened
 sail, at daylight wore ship to the South
 and made some sail, broke out water, saw
 the *Peris*, & So Ends. Lat 19. 00. S. Long 61. 36 E
*latter part
 rugged.*

Strong trades
 Saturday, July 27th 1861
 Comm. with strong trade heading South under
 short reef, bourses, Sillb. & spanker, at sunset
 shortened sail, at daylight made sail, latter
 part more moderate. Saw the *Peris*, So Ends.
 Latitude 19. 38. S. Longitude by Chron. 61. 29. E.

Brisk trades
 Sunday, July 28th 1861
 Begins with brisk trade heading N. E. under
 top sails, bourses, flying Sillb. V. at sunset took
 in sail, at 2. A. M. wore ship to the S. E. C.
 at daylight made all sail, saw the *Peris*, latter
 part moderate, So Ends. Lat 19. 37. S. Long

Squally.
 Monday, July 29th 1861
 Comm. with moderate trade, heading South
 under all sail, at 1. P. M. spoke the *Peris*, at
 sunset took in sail, at 2. A. M. wore ship to the
 Eastward latter part rainy & squally, saw
 three sails. So Ends. Lat 19. 52. S. Long

off Rodriguez. A. N. Perkins, Master
 Tuesday, July 30th 1861
 Comm. with squally weather heading to the
 N. E. under short sail, at 4. P. M. spoke
 the *Leophyr*, and wore ship to the South,
 middle part squally, at daylight wore
 ship to the N. E. at 8. A. M. spoke the *Leophyr*,
 and the *Peris* latter part better weather, So
 Ends. Lat by Obs. 19. 39. S. Long 61. 37. East.

 Peris.*
 Wednesday, July 31st 1861
 Begins with brisk trade heading N. E. under
 moderate sail, in company with the *Leophyr*,
 and *Peris*, at 2. P. M. wore ship to the South
 at sunset shortened sail, at daylight made
 sail & wore ship to the N. E. Saw two sails
 So Ends. Lat 19. 40. S. Long 61. 38. East

Fresh trades
 Thursday, August 1st 1861
 Comm. with fresh trade under moderate
 sail heading to the South, at sunset took
 in sail, at sunrise made all sail and
 wore ship to the N. E. Saw three sails,
 broke out meat, water, V. So Ends. Lat 19. 38. S. Long 61. 48

Brisk trades
 Friday August 2nd 1861
 Begins with brisk trade heading to the Eastward,
 under all sail at sunset shortened sail, at
 daylight made sail, saw the *Peris*, at 11. A. M.
 shortened sail, blowing strong So Ends. Lat 19. 40. S.
 Long 62. 30. E.

*Sail
 Mending.*
 Saturday, August 3rd 1861
 Comm. with strong trade heading E. N. E. under short
 sail, unbent the Main top sail and repaired it,
 at 3. 30. P. M. wore ship to the S. E. W. blowing
 strong, at sunset took in the Fore sail, and
 set the Spencers, middle & latter parts blowing
 a strong gale, bent the Main top sail and
 set it close reefed, Bore new reef tackles.
 So Ends. Latitude by Observation, 19. 59. S.
 no Longitude.
