all sail. at 3. P. M. spoke the Champions.
at sunset shortened sail, lay aback, part
of the Knight, at daylight saw Rodrigue.
made sail. Saw several sails set up the
Mizzen Rigging. So Ends. strong breeze latter part.
Latitude by Obs. 29.58. S. Long 62.42. East

Setting up
Miz. Rigging. Saturday, August 17th 1861
Begins with strong trade and squally, under
whole top sails & setting up the Miz. Rigging.
saw the Hattien? at sunset took in sail
heading South, at 3 P. M. wore ship in shore
and made same sail saw 11. Sails. So Ends.
with strong trade. Lat 30.03. S. Long 62.45

Strong trade. Sunday, August 18th 1861
All these 24 hours strong trade, was king
to the windward under double reefs & S
saw the Land and seven sails. So Ends. Lat 29.57. S.

Strong trade. Monday, August 19th 1861
comd. with strong trade and some squally.
heading to the South under double reefs & courses
Sith V. at 3. P. M. took in the main sail, Sith & Miz.
top sail. at 4. P. M. saw a Bark and thought she
was whaling, run off for her, and made sail, but
she saw nothing at sunset shortened sail, heading
South, at daylight headed in shore blowing fresh
saw the Land and 10 sails. So Ends. Lat 30.02. S

A. Pamela
B. America
Bk. Pearl. Tuesday, August 20th 1861
Begins with brisk trade. under double reefs.
at 3. P. M. spoke the Pamela. at 6. P. M. spoke
the Bark America, boiling, spoke the Bark Pearl
Middle and latter parts more moderate.
saw several sails, So Ends. Lat 19.50. South

off the Sale of Rodrigue, A. N. Perkins, Master,
Wednesday, August 21st 1861
Young Phoenix comd. with brisk trade under top sails & S.
at 4. P. M. spoke the Minervy Smith, the Hattien
and the Young Phoenix. at 8. P. M. spoke the
Ship Brewster, and the Bark Draco. at 11. P. M.
wore ship to the South, Middle & latter parts
strong trade. Saw 10 sails. So Ends. Lat 20.20. S

Bk. Hattien. Thursday, August 22nd 1861
All these 24 hours strong trade and rugged,
under short sail working to windward, spoke
the Hattien, saw seven ships, set up the
Main Rigging. So Ends. Lat 20.24. S

Strong trade. Friday August 23rd 1861
comd. with strong trade under short sail working
to the windward. Saw 14 ships. middle & latter
part blowing strong. So Ends. Lat 20.57. S.

Bk. Navigator. Saturday, August 24th 1861
All these 24 hours strong trade under short sail.
spoke the Bark Navigator, of Sagartown. Fisher,
Master. 34 months 600. S. and the America.
filled 4 casks of Salt water. So Ends, under the
reef

Bk. M. Smith. Sunday August 25th 1861
comd. with strong trade, having off and on
under the reef, under short sail. spoke the
Minervy Smith, and stood off shore, at 4. P. M.
wore ship in shore. middle & latter parts.
strong trade & rugged. Jamming with the
Minervy Smith. So Ends. Lat. none.

Strong trade. Monday, August 26th 1861
All these 24 hours strong trade, and rugged
under double reefs. Sith. & Fore Sails filled
4 casks of Salt water in the lower hold
forward. Saw 14 sails. and the Land.
So Ends. no observation, the Land, bearing
East 20 miles Dist.
