

Ship Plover, of New Bedford, Bound Rainey,	Sunday, April 27 th 1862 Comm. with brisk trade, steering N.W. all sail out, middle part rainey, the wind shifting from S.E. to S.W. shortened sail, latter part light trade, all sail out, saw nothing, so ends. Lat. 4. 18. S. Long 44	Hornet Caught a Porpoise,	Augustus N. Perkins, Master, Saturday, May, 3 rd 1862 Comm. with light breeze from S.E. to N.E. heading from N.E. to N.W. all sail out, baled out the Black fish, and caught a Porpoise, saw 4 sails, at 4. P.M. got a breeze from N.W. W. Ship. Heading N.E. all sail out, at 7. 30. took in the light sails, parted the wheel ropes, and sewed a new one. Saw a large ship steering South, heaving up reefs fore & Miz. Top Sails, latter part moderate made sail, the wind N.W. E. Saw a sail. Saw Porpoises. So ends. Lat 1. 16. S.
Rainey,	Monday, April 28 th 1862 Begins with light trade & baffling, steered N.W. by N. under all sail, middle part rainey, latter part the wind all around, and some rainey, so ends. no observations	New wheel Ropes	Sunday, May 4 th 1862 Begins with a light breeze from the S.E. and fine weather, heading to the N.W. under all sail at 1. 30. P. boarded the Ship George, Turner of Portland, Me., Master, 36. days from Portland bound to Beaufort, N.C. at 4. 30. P. M. saw Beaches one point on the weather Bow 5 miles off, but saw nothing more of them, latter part the wind S.W. E. all the kites out, so ends. Latitude by observation, 00. 03 miles South. Long 21. 22. W.
New Fore Main tacks,	Tuesday, April 29 th 1862 Comm. with light winds and variable, with heavy rain, at 4. P.M. the wind S.E. steered N.W. W. under all sail, except T. G. Studding Sails, middle part clear, latter part rainey. Cove New Fore & Main tacks, so ends. Lat 3. 16. S. Long 24. 31. W.	Ship George Tide Sails,	Wednesday, April 30 th 1862 All these 24 hours light air and variable with smart rain squalls, shortened & made sail, water two sails. so ends. Latitude by observation, 30. 34. South,
Rainey	Thursday, May 1 st 1862 Comm. with light air and baffling from all points. Trying to head to the N.W. Saw two sails, latter part light air, boarded the French Bark, Eguque, of Bordeaux 29. days from Bordeaux, bound to Arica, & Salé, Peru. Saw Black Fish and the Larboard Boat got one, the Bow Boat got a cow fish so ends. Lat, 3. 22. South, Long, 24. 57. W.	Sail Mending	Friday, May 2 nd 1862 Comm. with a light breeze from the South to S.E. all sail out steering N. by W. middle part some rainey, latter part light breeze from S.E. repaired the Main Ropes. So ends. Saw Black fish. Lat. by obs. 37 miles N. Lon. 25. 37 W.
Black fish	Friday, May 2 nd 1862 All these 24 hours light air & baffling, from all points. Heading from West to East, under all sail saw two sails, so ends. Lat 3. 19. South	Squally	Saturday, May 3 rd 1862 Comm. with a light breeze from the S.W. E. under all sail, steering N.W. at 3. P.M. had a squall of wind & rain at 4. Calm, middle part some rainey, latter part squally & calm. So ends. Lat by obs. 59. miles North, Long by obs. 25. 53. W. June 26. 09. W.
French Bark Eguque	Saturday, May 3 rd 1862 Comm. with a light breeze from the S.W. E. under all sail, steering N.W. at 3. P.M. had a squall of wind & rain at 4. Calm, middle part some rainey, latter part squally & calm. So ends. Lat by obs. 59. miles North, Long by obs. 25. 53. W. June 26. 09. W.	Captain Sick,	Sunday, May 4 th 1862 Comm. with a light breeze from the S.W. E. under all sail, steering N.W. at 3. P.M. had a squall of wind & rain at 4. Calm, middle part some rainey, latter part squally & calm. So ends. Lat by obs. 59. miles North, Long by obs. 25. 53. W. June 26. 09. W.
