

4th Friday December 6th 1833

Come with strong gales and squally at 5 P.M. took in the fore and main topsails steering S.E. by E. wind N.E. at 5 close reefed the fore and main topsails at 9 P.M. took in the mainsail fore topsail and fore sail blowing a gale from the N.E. with a bad sea on strong gales and squally through the night latter part strong gales and squally with a large sea on wind N.E. Lat by Obs. 34° 44' N Long by acc 69° 03' W

5th Saturday December 7th 1833

Come with a strong gale from N.E. and squally with a heavy sea on Middle part. More moderate at 2 P.M. set the topsails close reefed and fore sail at 8 P.M. Made more sail strong breezes Lat by Obs. 34° 29' N Long by account 68° 20' W Long by Chro. 67° 04' W

6th Sunday December 8th 1833

Come with strong breezes from N.E. by E. steering E. and E. by S. at 2 P.M. bent the fore main topsail strong breezes through the night from N.E. by E. to E. by N. and squally at 9 P.M. were ship steered N.N.E. wind E. by S. Lat by Obs. 33° 53' N Long by account 67° 25' W Long by Chro. 66° 04' W

7th Monday December 9th 1833

Come with strong gales steering N.E. by N. and N.N.E. wind E. by S. and E. S. E. at 4 P.M. close reefed the topsails at 6 P.M. took in the fore course and main topsail at 6 P.M. took in the fore topsail and lay by blowing strong from the E. with a bad sea on strong gales and squally through the night latter part more moderate Long by account 67° 18' W Lat by Obs. 34° 52' N Long by Chro. 66° 00' W

8th Tuesday December 10th 1833

Come with strong breezes from S.E. by E. Made sail and steered E. by N. a heavy swell from the S.E. at 2 P.M. the wind shifted to the N.W. steered East. Made more sail light breezes through the night from N.W. to North latter part light airs and calm employed in setting up the Rigging Lat by Obs. 34° 54' N Longitude 65° 00' W

9th Wednesday December 11th 1833

Come with light airs from N.W. steering E. by S. employed in setting up the Rigging light breezes through the night from North steered East latter part fresh breezes and squally steered E. by S. Lat by Obs. 34° 39' N Long by account 63° 12' W

10th Thursday December 12th 1833

Come with fresh breezes from N.N.E. steering E. by S. at 6 P.M. took in the fore and main top & sails strong breezes and raining from the N.E. and N.N.E. at 1 P.M. saw a ship steering to the Westward brisk breezes and raining through the night steered E. by S. and S.E. by E. latter part strong breezes steered S.E. by E. wind N.E. by E. Lat by Obs. 33° 39' N Long by Chro. 62° 00' W

11th Friday December 13th 1833

Come with moderate breezes from N.E. steering steering) E. by S. Middle part moderate breezes from N.E. to North steered E. by S. and East latter part light breezes from N.W. by N. with a squally appearance steering East Lat by Obs. 33° 40' N Long by Chro. 60° 31' W
