Come with strong breezes from S. W. steering E. b. N. at 1 P.M. set the top gallantsails strong breezes at 3 P.M. took in the top S sails and Mainsail strong breezes from West steering E. b. N. latter part strong gales from W. b. N. steering E. b. N. Lat by Obs. 34° 30' N

15th Tuesday December 17th 1833

Come with strong gales and squally from W. N. W. steering East with heavy sea on at 1 P.M. double reefed the Mainsail strong gales through the Night from N.W. to North steering East latter part More Moderate Made sail steered E. b. S. wind N. b. E. with a great swell setting the N. E.

Come with brisk breezes from N. N. E. steering E. b. S. with a great swell from the N. E. Middle part light airs and calm latter part brisk breezes from S. E. b. S. steering E. N. E. at 11 M. bent a New Fore top sail

17th Thursday December 19th 1833

Come with strong breezes from S. E. steering E. b. N. at 5 P.M. double reefed the Topsails at 10 P.M. took the Mainsail and Stb in and Mizen topsail at 11 took in the fore top topsail at 1 M. took in the Foresail blowing strong gales from S. E. and Hailing at 3 M. the wind shifted to the S. W. set the fore sail and fore topsail steered East strong gales and squally at 8 More Moderate & Made sail steered East

W. steering East Lat by Obs. 36° 02' N

19th Saturday December 21st 1833

Come with strong gales from S. W. b. W. steering E. b. S. at 8 P.M. took the Fore sail in at 10 took the fore topsail in and luffed to by the wind a blowing heavy from W. S. W. with a heavy sea on Middle part strong gales and squally with a heavy latter part More Moderate Lat by Obs. 38° 57' N
