108^o Wednesday March 19th 1834
Comms with strong gales and squally from
W.S.W. strong gales through the right from S.W. to
W.S.W. latter part Moderate Made sail and
steered W.S.W. with a great swell from the
W.S.W. Lat by Obs 47^o 28.8
Long by Chron. 46^o 35.7'
