Monday July 7. 1834

The fore part of this day begins with brisk breezes at 3 P.M. got underway and stood to sea in company with the L.C. Richmond steered out N.W. at 4 M. steered N.W. latter part light breezes

Tuesday July 8. 1834

The fore part of this day begins with light breezes steering N.W. in company with the L.C. Richmond. Moderate breezes through the Night steered N.W. at 6 M. saw Sperm Whales lowered and chased at 11. took up the boats and chased with the ship - -

Long 83° 10'

Wednesday July 9. 1834

begins with moderate breezes

at 2 P.M. lowered for the whales again to no purpose at 4 took up the boats and braced by the wind light breezes through the Night tacked twice during the Night latter part light breezes steering N.W.

Long 83° 40'

Thursday July 11. 1834

begins with light breezes steering N.W. in company with the L.C. Richmond light breezes through the Night steering West latter part light breezes steered N.W.

Lat by Obs 3° 26'

Long 85° 20'

Friday July 11. 1834

The fore part of this day begins with light breezes steering N.W. calm through the Night latter part light breezes steered West. Lat by Obs 3° 32'

Long 86° 30'

Saturday July 12. 1834

The fore part of this day begins with light breezes from South steering West in company with the Richmond light breezes through the Night steered West latter part light breezes

Lat by Obs 3° 19'

Long 88° 25' W.

Sunday July 13. 1834

The fore part of this day begins with light breezes steering West in company with the L.C. Richmond at 8 steered N.W. latter part moderate breezes steered N.W.

Lat by Obs 2° 22'

Long 89° 52' W.

Monday July 14. 1834

The fore part of this day begins with light breezes steering N.W. in company with the L.C. Richmond at 6 P.M. lay by at 6 M. kept off steered N.W. at 11 M. saw the Land steered N.W. latter part light breezes

Lat by Obs 1° 53'

Long 90° 25' West

Tuesday July 15. 1834

The fore part of this day begins with light breezes steering N.W. Middle part light breezes lay about at 5 M. made sail stood for the Island latter part light breezes

Lat by Obs 1° 26'

Long 90° 25'

Wednesday July 16. 1834

The fore part of this day begins with light breezes at 4 got in with the Land & wore round headed off light airs through the Night steered N.W. latter part light airs steering N.W. the Abund of Albatross in sight
