The fore part of this day begins with light breezes standing to the Eastward latter part fresh breezes

Long by Obs 92° 09'

Wednesday August 13th 1834
The fore part of this day begins with brisk breezes and cloudy latter part fresh breezes and showery
Lat 11° 40'
Long 92° 30'

Thursday August 14th 1834
The fore part of this day begins with fresh breezes and showery at 4 AM saw the Island of Culpeper at 6 tacked to the westward at 2 PM tacked to the Eastward latter part fresh breezes
Lat by Ob. 11° 27'
Long by Obs 91° 51'

Friday August 15th 1834
The fore part of this day begins with brisk breezes at 4 AM of shore Culpeper Island bearing N.E. by E. dist 10 Miles at 2 PM tacked to the Eastward latter part light breezes the Islands in sight
Lat 11° 28' N
Long 92° 10' W

Saturday August 16th 1834
The fore part of this day begins with light breezes latter part light breezes the current setting South Westward
Lat by Ob 10° 57' N

Sunday August 17th 1834
The fore part of this day begins with light breezes Albemarle Island in sight light breezes through the night at 11 AM saw whales off the lee anchorage
Lat 11° 15' N

Monday August 18th 1834
The fore part of this day begins with light breezes at 2 PM lowered and killed a small whale at 6 got him made fast to the ship hood of shore at 7 cut in the whale were ship stood shore both breezes
Lat by Ob 10° 18' N

Tuesday August 19th 1834
The fore part of this day begins with moderate breezes (ships in sight) at 6 tacked of shore the current setting to the westward at 6 AM came anchoring latter part moderate breezes
Lat 10° 09' N
at 2 PM Long by Obs 91° 19' West

Wednesday August 20th 1834
The fore part of this day begins with light breezes at 4 AM spoke the Mark Asper Newfoundland Capt. Milder 26 No. Oct 400 lbs at 2 finished hoisting latter part light breezes steering N.W.
Lat by Ob 10° 37'
Long 92° 15'

Thursday August 21th 1834
The fore part of this day begins with light breezes steering N.E. at 2 AM tacked of the wind stood to the westward latter part brisk breezes steered E.S.E.
Lat 10° 57' N
Long 92° 00'

Friday August 22th 1834
The fore part of this day begins with fresh breezes showery latter part light breezes steered S.E. by E.
Lat 11° 30' N
Long 91° 29' W

Saturday August 23th 1834
The fore part of this day begins with light breezes and rainy latter part fresh breezes and squally Culpeper in sight
Lat 11° 30' N
Long 91° 50' W

Sunday August 24th 1834
The fore part of this day begins with light breezes and squally at 3 tacked N.W. latter part fresh breezes the Culpeper Island in sight

Monday August 25th 1834
The fore part of this day begins with strong breezes latter part fresh breezes and thick
