The fore part of this day comes with light breezes at 1 PM saw Sperm Whales at 2 lowered struck a large whale at 8 AM got him made fast to the ship at 6 AM commencing cutting at 11 finished Lat by Obs. 8° 41'

Sunday January 4. 1835

The fore part of this day begins with light breezes at 2 lowered lowered for Sperm Whales at 2 struck and killed the whale at 3 took him alongside commencing cutting at 6 got the body in at 8 commencing boiling at 8 AM hooked on to the head at 11 finished made sail Lat by Obs. 8° 14'

Monday January 5. 1835

The fore part of this day begins with light breezes Employed in boiling cutting up Junk & at 3 started to the Southward latter part light breezes 8° 38'
