Saturday February 28.

Come with brisk Trades at 5. At 16 the Ship Ruffed got underway and went to sea at 6. the liberty men returned on board at 8. At 2 hands ashore on liberty

Sunday March 1. 1835

Come with light trades Macabul - Macabaster and William V. Clock stopped on shore the rest returned on board at 8. At William V. Clock and archabul Macabaster returned on board

Monday March 2. 1835

Come with fresh breezes & shipped Henry Water at 9. At got underway and stood out to sea with 4 men short

Tuesday March 3. 1835

Begins with fresh breezes foggy steering West) latter part calm

Long 179. 10

Wednesday March 4.

Come with light airs from S.E. steering N.W. W. latter part light breezes steering N.W. W.
Lat by Obs 8. 55
Long by Obs 80. 14

Thursday March 5.

Come with light breezes from S.E. steering N.W. W. Middle and latter part light breezes
Lat by Obs 7. 53
Long by Obs 80. 26

Friday March 6

Begins with light airs from S.E. steering N.W. W. Middle and latter part light breezes
Lat by Obs 6. 52
Long by Obs 81. 16

Saturday March 7

Begins with light airs from S.E. steering N.W. W. Middle part brisk breezes latter part light breezes the land in sight
Lat by Obs 5. 33
Long by Obs 81. 23

Sunday March 8. 1835

Come with light breezes steering N.W. E. the land in sight at 7. A.M. lay about headwinds off shore Middle and latter part calm
Land in sight Lat by Obs 5. 18

Monday March 9.

The fore part of this day begins with light breezes from N.W. steering S.E. at 6. A.M. calm at 8. At a light breeze sprang up from the Southward and steered in for Day's point

Tuesday March 10

The fore part of this day Come with light breezes from the Southward at 2 P.M. came to in 10 fathoms water with the small breeze latter part light airs and calm

Wednesday March 11.

The fore part of this day come with light breezes from at 4. A.M. the Vincent's ship a frigate from Panama Bay at 8. At shipped 2 men took them off at 11. cleared out from the Customhouse shipped Charles Porter up Boatsteerer

Thursday March 12

Come with fresh breezes at 4. A.M. have short names of those men shipped at Day's Joseph Reid Joseph Wright Thomas Burgess John Miller John Adams Paul Fry) those three last Natives of the Sandwich Islands) at 4. At got underway and stood out to sea

Come with light breezes pleasant some black fog Middle and latter part light winds

Saturday March 14

Come with light breezes steering S.W. W. S. latter part light air
Lat by Obs 6. 13

Begins with light breezes 2. spoke the ship Brown on water 17. At 8. 55 latter part light breezes steering S.W. W.
