Sunday June 7.
begins with moderate breezes pleasant
latter part fresh breezes Lat by Obs 10° 33'

Monday June 8.
begins with moderate breezes
latter part moderate breezes Lat by Obs 11° 21'

Tuesday June 9.
begins with moderate breezes
latter part light breezes Lat by Obs 11° 30'

Wednesday June 10.
begins with light breezes pleasant
latter part brisk breezes Lat by Obs 3° 07'

Thursday June 11.
begins with brisk breezes employed
in cooping oil and stowing it down the
blubber room at 4 AM. spoke the schooner Victoria
Henry J. 22. days from Baltimore short of
water let him have 40 gallons latter part brisk
breezes Lat by Obs 2° 33'

Friday June 12.
begins with fresh breezes at 4 AM.
saw sperm whales lowered and
struck two whales at 11. got the whales made
fast to the ship at daylight wore ship and
hooked on to the whale Lat by Obs 2° 50'

Saturday June 13.
begins with strong breezes at 5. got
the bodies up and lay by the heads at Meridian
got in the heads Lat by Obs 2° 55'

Sunday June 14. 1835
begins with strong breezes with
a rough sea on at 3. Comm. Boiling
at 7 AM. saw sperm whales at 9 AM. lowered
and struck Lat by Obs 13° 55'

Monday June 15.
begins with fresh breezes Employed
in Boiling at 1 P.M. got the whale made
fast to the ship latter part brisk breezes
Employed in cutting at Lat by Obs 3° 49'

Tuesday June 16.
begins with brisk breezes Employed
in cutting at 4 finished comm. boiling on ship
in sight latter part strong breezes Lat by Obs 3° 33'

Wednesday June 17.
begins with strong breezes Employed
Boiling at 7 finished boiling at 10 AM. spoke the
Brick Washington 230 Bbls. latter part fresh breezes
Lat by Obs 4° 10'

Thursday June 18.
begins with strong breezes latter
part fresh breezes Employed in breaking out
the main hatchway and stowing oil Lat by Obs 3° 37'

Friday June 19.
begins with strong breezes Employed
in stowing down oil latter part fresh breezes
Lat by Obs 4° 35'

Saturday June 20.
begins with strong breezes Employed
in stowing down oil latter part strong breezes
and squally Employed in sending down
the fore top & Mast & Mizen
Lat by Obs 4° 23'
