begins with fresh breezes N.E. W.
steering S.W. Middle and latter part light breezes
from S.W. to North and raining Lat - 13° 03'
Long By Chis 145° 47'

Sunday August 30th
begins with light breezes from N.E. W. W.
raining steering S.W. latter part calm and in
sight Lat 13° 37' 51"
Long By Chis 146° 18'
Long By Obs. 145° 52'

Monday August 31st
begins with calm weather latter
part light air from the N.E. steering S.W. By W.
Lat 13° 49'

de Kusensteen bearing S.W. dist 12 Miles
latter part light air from S.E. Lat 14° 54'
at 90. W. Long By Chis 148° 53'

Thursday Sept 3rd
begins with fresh breezes and squally

at 11 got down and got the Dial on Board

Saturday Sept 5th

in 8 fathoms water with the best
power at 2 P.M. one half of the crew on liberty
Sunday Sept 6th
comes with light air from the S.W.
at 6 P.M. the Harbour returned on board
the Harbour went ashore

begins with pleasant weather
at 6 P.M. the coopers commenced caulking the Ship
