begins with strong breezes raining

Thursday Dec 10.
begins with strong breezes employed

Long. 176° 10'

Friday Dec 11.
begins with brisk breezes employed
stowing off the main hatchway with oil
latter part strong breezes Lat. 26° 00'
Long. 176° 00'

Saturday Dec 12.
begins with strong breezes
latter part moderate Long. 175° 40. Lat. [redacted]

Sunday Dec 13
begins with brisk breezes
Middle and latter part strong breezes Lat. 26° 23'
Long. 175° 30'

Monday Dec 14. 1835
begins with strong gales cloudy
Middle and latter part strong gales Lat. 26° 40'
Long. 176° 00'

Tuesday Dec 15.
begins with strong gales and raining
from E.W. latter part strong gales squally
at 8. M. took the main topsail in Lat. 25° 00'
Long. 176° 30'

Wednesday Dec 16
begins with a heavy gale from
S.E. laying under a mizen staysail
Middle part more moderate latter strong gales
at 9. M. ship set the fore and main top
sails steered East. Lat. 24° 10'
Long. 175° 45'

Thursday Dec 17.
begins with strong breezes steering
East latter part moderate Lat. 23° 58'
Long. 174° 40'

Friday Dec 18.
begins with light breezes from N.W.
steering S.E. latter part light airs employed in
shifting the main top & mast Lat. 23° 40'
Long. 174° 50'

Saturday Dec 19
begins with light airs from S.E.
steering S.W. at 2. spoke the Walrus London
latter part fresh breezes Lat. 23° 15'
Long. 174° 10'

Sunday Dec 20.
begins with fresh breezes squally
latter part fresh breezes Lat. 23° 07'
Long. 174° 12'

Monday Dec 21.
begins with fresh breezes steering S.W.
latter part fresh breezes employed in repairing
the main topsail saw a ship boiling Lat. 22° 28'
Long. 174° 55'
