Saturday January 2<sup>nd</sup>  
begins with light breeze from the North steering  
East at 4 P.M. saw Sunday Island bearing East Dist. 20 Miles  
light air through the Night from S.W. steered S.W.  
latter part light breezes steered S.W. at 11. AM saw  
Maucauly Island bearing S.W. Dist 30 Miles Lat 29° 48'  
Long 178° 30'

Sunday Jan 3<sup>rd</sup>  
begins with light air from West steering S.E.  
at 1 P.M. saw sperm whale lowered the Boats in pursuit  
lost the run of him at 5 took up the Boats light breezes  
through the Night latter part strong breezes and  
hazy

Long 175° 00'

Monday Jan 4<sup>th</sup>  
begins with strong breezes from N.W.  
raining at 4 P.M. spoke the Tacia of New Bedford  
Capt. Latta 16. M. out 60. Bbls Middle and latter part  
strong breezes squally

Long By Ob. 177° 27'

Tuesday Jan 5<sup>th</sup>  
begins with strong breezes squally from West  
saw Maucauly Island and latter part strong gales  
squally  
Lat By Ob. 30° 06'

Wednesday Jan 6<sup>th</sup>  
begins with strong breezes squally at 6. Maucauly Isl.  
Bore S.W. latter part light breezes
