at daylight saw the Island of Navarino bearing
N.E. dist 6 leagues at 8 A.M. saw Sperm Whales
lowered and struck 2 Whales at Maroonian
got one made fast to the ship Lat by Ob. 24° 00' S
Long by Chron. 148° 00' W

Tuesday April 19
begins with moderate breezes from S.E. & S.W.
great swell on at 1 P.M. commenced cutting at 4 P.M.
steered N.W. the Island North point bore at 6 P.M.
E.N.E. dist 10 Miles at 7 P.M. began to boil latter
part brisk breezes
Lat by Ob. 22° 42' S
Long by Chron. 148° 11' W

Wednesday April 20.
begins with brisk breezes from S.W.
steering N.W. at 6 P.M. finished boiling Middle and
latter part light breezes showery
Lat 21° 02' S
Long by Chron. 148° 02' W

Thursday April 21.
begins with light breezes from S.E. steering
North Employed in getting up the fore and main
poop Gallies Mast latter part light breezes
from N.W. & S.W.
Lat by Ob. 19° 55' S
Long by Chron. 147° 50' W

Friday April 22.
begins with light breezes from S.W. steering
N.W. & S.W. Employed in washing the ship's masts
latter part light airs from N.W. & S.W.
Lat by Ob. 19° 22' S
Long by Chron. 147° 28' W

Saturday April 23.
begins with light airs from N.W. & S.W. standing
to the North Middle part calm latter part light
breezes from S.E. & S.W. steering N.W. & S.W.
(Current setting to the E.ward)
Lat by Ob. 19° 03' S
Long by Chron. 147° 22' W
