

Sunday May 15. 1836.
 Begins with pleasant weather
 one half of the ship's company up to the
 at 9. We got underway and got out to sea
 and shipped John Davis John Young Jack Mit
 Bonaparte. Thomas Davis the 4 last natives
 of the Sandwich Islands

Monday May 16
 begins with fresh breezes stood over
 towards Kethuroa. Employed in stowing
 the anchors chains &c. at 7 AM got in under
 Kethuroa too much reef on to sail at 8 Steered
 W. by S. W.

Tuesday May 17.
 begins with brisk breezes
 steering N.W. at 10 lay aback at 3 AM kept off
 for St. C. Savides Island at 10 got under
 sent in the boat. Lat. 17° 46'

Wednesday May 18.
 begins with light air from N.W. by N.
 at 2 P.M. the boat returned with pigs and farns
 went on shore the second time at 4 returned
 with more pigs and farns. stood off and on
 through the night at 8 AM sent in two boats

Thursday May 19
 begins with brisk breezes from N.W. by W.
 at 2 P.M. the boat returned on board
 with pigs and farns. I stood off to the N.W.
 strong breezes and squally through the night
 N.W. to South latter part light breezes steering
 N.W. Charles & Island in sight Lat 17° 45' S
 Long 150° 30 W

Friday May 20
 begins with light breezes showery wind
 South steering N.W. Middle part calm
 latter part light breezes from N.W. by N.
 Lat 17° 37' S
 Long 151° 30 W

Saturday May 21.
 begins with light breezes from N.W. by W.
 Employed in mending the sails
 Boat Blister in sight latter part light
 breezes from N.W. by W. Lat 18° 26' S
 Long 153° 15' W

Sunday May 22.
 begins with light breezes from W. by N.
 at 2 P.M. tacked to the North
 light breezes through the night from South
 steered North. Lat 16° 41' S
 Long by Chron 153° 08' W

Monday May 23.
 begins with light breezes from S. by E.
 steering N.W. (Maurara Island bearing
 E. N.E. dist. 20 miles latter part light breezes
 Employed in mending sails Lat 15° 11' S
 Long 153° 38 W

Tuesday May 24
 begins with light breezes from South
 steering N.W. latter part light air Lat 14° 11' S
 Long by Chron 153° 42 W

Wednesday May 25.
 begins with light breezes from S. by E.
 steering N.W. latter part light breezes
 from S. by E. Lat 13° 11' S
 Long by Chron 154° 22 W

Thursday May 26.
 begins with light breezes from S. by E.
 N.W. Employed in sail mending
 at 7 AM saw sperm whales at 8 lowered got fast
 two boats lines parted lost 3 farns. latter
 part heavy. Lat 12° 20' S
 Long 154° 35 W

Friday May 27
 begins with light breezes from N.W. by E.
 latter part light breezes from East steering
 North. Lat 12° 29' S
 Long by Chron 154° 34 W
