Monday Oct 17

Begins with light breezes from N.W. steering E.S.E. Middle part calm latter part light breezes from N.W. Lat By Ob. 29° 26' N. Long By Cha. 168° 38' W.

Tuesday Oct 18.

Begins with light air from W.N.W. steering East. latter part. Indian ship in sight. Lat By Ob. 29° 26' N. Long. 168° 25' W.

Wednesday Oct 19

Begins with light breezes from W.N.W. steering E.S.E. Middle and latter part calm. Lat By Ob. 29° 26' N. Long By Cha. 166° 52' W.

Thursday Oct 20

Begins with calm weather latter part light breezes from E.S.E. to E.S.E. Lat By Ob. 30° 02' N. Long. 166° 32' W.

Friday Oct 21.

Begins with light breezes from S.E. having at 10 P.M. a squall out of the N.W. to left in sail at 4 A.M. lay by. Bad sea of from the North at 9 A.M. Moderate Made sail steered East. wind North. Lat By Ob. 29° 19' N. Long. 165° 11' West.

Saturday Oct 22. 1836

Begins with strong breezes from North steering East at 4 P.M. close reefed the topsails took in the 2nd strong breezes squally latter part Moderate breezes from N.W. Lat By Ob. 28° 30' N. Long By Cha. 163° 30' W.

Sunday Oct 23.

Begins with light breezes from W.N.W. steering East. latter part strong breezes from N.W. steering E.S.E. Lat By Ob. 28° 00' N. Long. By Cha. 161° 09' W.

Monday Oct 24

Begins with strong breezes from S.W. steering E.S.E. Middle part strong breezes from West steering S.E. latter part strong breezes from N.W. steering S.E. Lat By Ob. 26° 31' N. Long. 159° 13' W.

Tuesday Oct 25.

Begins with strong breezes from N.W. steering S.E. latter part strong breezes from N.W. steering S.E. Lat By Ob. 24° 16' N. Long. By Cha. 158° 57' W.

Wednesday Oct 26

Begins with light breezes employed in boarding the chains getting the anchors of the Bow 8. at 4 P.M. came to in 13 fathoms water with the best Bower a breast of the foremast to the back of the Bow.
