part light breezes from E.N.E. steering to
the North by the Wind at 15. At 11 saw the
Land dist 25 miles at 11 took off shore

Long 10° 14' W

Wednesday April 26
begins with light steering N.N.E. by the
wind at 3 took off shore latter part light
breezes
Lat 11° 34' S
Long 10° 11' W

Thursday April 27
begins with light breezes from E.B.S.
at 5 AM took to the N.E. at 8 AM the wind
shifted to the N.E. took to the South East.
at 2 PM took to the N.E. latter part fresh
breezes from S.E.B.S.

Long 10° 52' W

Friday April 28. 1837
begins with fresh breezes from
S.E.B.E. steering to the N.E. & North and
latter part strong breezes from S.E. to E.S.E.
Lat 9° 36' S
Long 10° 35' W

Saturday April 29
begins with light breezes from S.E.B.S.
steering to the N.E. Land in sight about 20
miles dist. latter part light breezes from S.E.
steering N.B.E. Land in sight
Lat 8° 14' S
Long 10° 29' W
at 9 AM the Land Dist 20 miles the Cape St. Roque
Lat 2° 28'

Sunday April 30
begins with light breezes from S.E. steering
North at 3.30 PM Long 10° 23' S the Land of
Gundia West Tower 15 miles off shore - 34° 51' the Land
saw a big Boating up the Coast 2° 28' saw a number of
Cattermarans latter part light breezes
Lat 6° 13' S

Monday May 1. 1837
begins with light breezes from S.E. steering
N.B.W. at 4 PM Point Negra. Dist 14 miles
Point Negra Long 35° 12' Long by Chron 35° 09' W
North of the Chron 1° 11' 46" losing 8 seconds daily
latter part fresh breezes steering N.B.W.
Lat 3° 50' S
Long 10° 25' W

Tuesday May 2.
begins with fresh breezes from S.E.B.S.
steering N.N.W. latter part strong
Lat 1° 40' S
Long 10° 15' W
