of these 24 hours strong whole sail breezes from
the E ship heading by the wind to the S middle & latter
parts the same to day saw two
sails one heading S the other SE
Lat 5° 53'
Long 32° 53'

39 days Remarks Sunday Nov 23rd
first part
of these 24 hours strong whole sail
breezes from the E ship heading
by the wind to the S middle &
latter parts the same. to day
the capt. lost an oil packet out
of the Round house. & on inquiry
found that one Manuel & Portugues
ad stolen it out of the round house
were upon the capt. gave him
a good chastise to end the day

40 days Remarks Monday Nov 24th
first part
of these 24 hours fine whole sail
breezes from the E ship heading
by the wind to the S at 5 AM
caught a purple middle & latter
parts the same employed
on ship duty
Lat 10° 57' S
Long 33° 57'

41 days Remarks Tuesday Nov 25th
first part
of these 24 hours strong breezes
from the E ship heading S SE
middle & latter parts the same so
ends with the coopers making some
small line tubs
Lat 13° 57'
Long 33° 57'

42 days Remarks Wednesday Nov 26th
first part
strong whole sail breezes from the
E ship heading by the wind to
the S middle & latter parts very
much the same coopers employed
making line tubs to end the day
Lat 15° 15' S
Long 32° 39'

43 days Remarks Thursday Nov 27th
first part
of these 24 hours fine
whole sail breezes from the E ship
heading by the wind to the
S middle part the same latter
parts shales sail & canvas
beating out the head & floor to
coopers between decks & masts
Lat 19° 26' S
Long 32° 39'
