of these 24 hours light winds
& fine weather from the E ship
heading has course S & E middle
& latter parts very much the same
so ends the day
S at 23.37
Log 28.14

47 days Remarks Monday December 1st

first part
of these 24 hours fine whole sail
breezes from the E & N ship heading
has course S & E middle part the
same latter part strong winds
from the W so ends employed
in getting ready a New Main Tapsail
to bend
S at 25.58
Log 25.38

48 days out Remarks Tuesday December 2nd

first part
of these 24 hours strong winds
from the W ship heading has course
S & E at 4 AM Bent a new floor
main tapsail middle & latter parts
the same employed in ship's
duty

49 days Remarks Wednesday December 3rd

first part
of these 24 hours strong
winds from the W steering S & E
at 4 AM bent the main tapsail
to the fore at 5th saw a school
of sperm whales lowered & struck
one to the Starboard boat the
rest went to windward at 6 took
him a long ride & set the watch
employed getting ready to cut
middle & latter parts fine
employed in clearing away the whale
so ends the day
S at 29.10

first part
of these 24 hours light winds
from the W & E steering off S & E
at 2 AM saw a school of sperm
whales lowered & the main Boat
struck & spawd whales last seen
going to the W middle & latter
parts the same employed
sailing
