 of these 24 hours strong gale from
 the W. steering S.E. by E. at 1 P.M.
 saw a large lone whale took in the
 main sail & jib & two reef the fore &
 main topails then veered ship but
 saw no more of the whale it was
 blowing very hard from the W. so there
 was but a very small chance to catch him
 at 2 P.M. steamed off our course middle
 & latter parts more moderate turned
 out the reefs & set the jib & main sail
 latter parts set the main topail
 & flying jib so ends the day
