first part of
these 24 hours light winds from the E & S
the ship heading by the wind to the S with
one sail in sight of our lee beam at 3 o'clock
bent the new main staysail middle
part the wind auld to the N latter
part the same so ends the day

87 days Remarks Saturday Jan 10th

first part
of these 24 hours light winds & thick
from the N^W ship steering E by E
at 4 o'clock bent a new fore staysail
middle & latter parts very much the same
so ends the day Lat 37 36 S
Long 70 37 E
