 first part of these 24 hours strong winds from the S.E. ship cruising off on the Permaid middle & latter parts very thick weather Permaid bearing S.W. ship sailing under short sail with 8 sails in sight so ends

131 days Remarks Monday Feb 23^d
 first part of these 24 hours strong winds & thick weather from the S. ship cruising off & over middle & latter parts very much the same so ends with 4 sails in sight

132 days Remarks Tuesday February 24th
 first part of these 24 hours strong winds & fog from the S.E. ship cruising off over the Permaid middle part calm latter part at 10 P.M. joined with the following named ships Daniel Wood Pacific Adisap & Menirva Permaid in sight bearing W.N.W. distance 10 miles

133 days Remarks Wednesday Feb 25th
 first part of these 24 hours light winds & calm Permaid in sight middle & latter parts very fine but nothing in sight but ships & land so ends the day 6 ships in sight

134 days Remarks Thursday Feb 26th
 first part of these 24 hours light winds from the S.E. ship cruising off on the Permaid at sundown shortened sail middle & latter parts very foggy with light winds from the S.W. so ends the day

135 days Remarks Friday Feb 27th
 first part of these 24 hours light winds from the S. with plenty of fog cruising off the Permaid at 12 M. joined with the D^r Wood middle part very thick latter part cleared off so ends the day

136 days Remarks Saturday Feb 28th
 first part of these 24 hours calm & with the Permaid bearing W.N.W. distance 10 miles middle part the wind cold to the N. with thick weather nothing in sight to day
