137 days Remarks Sunday Feb March 1st

first part of these 24 hours light winds & rain from the N ship lying under short sail with the permaid bearing NW distance 10 miles middle parts the same latter part the wind veered to the W so ends the day

138 days Remarks Monday March 2nd

first part of these 24 hours strong winds from the SSW crossing off Bon middle & latter parts very fine we find that we have got a very strong set to the S & have got to carry sail to keep up so ends the day

139 days Remarks Tuesday March 3rd

first part of these 24 hours light winds from the NW working to the windward permaid bearing NW distance 10 miles middle & latter parts the same so ends the day

140 days Remarks Wednesday March 4th

first part of these 24 hours light winds & rain from the NW ship heading SSW at 5 PM the wind veered to the S middle part the same latter part at 7 PM kept up for Port but at 12 PM came too in 8 fathoms of water & came getting ready to point ship so ends

142 days Thursday March 5th

laying at anchor at port hut with a strong gale from the N at 5 PM it moderated wind veered to the SW so ends

143 days Remarks Friday March 6th

at 6 this morning it blew on to a heavy gale from the SW gave her the 2nd anchor at 11 PM more moderate wind to day the Bark Addison

144 days Remarks Saturday Mar 7th

at 7 AM commencing painting ship with all hands at 5 PM got through received on board to day 675 lbs of potatoes & 40 of onions so ends the day

145 days Remarks Sunday March 8th

light winds from the N ship lying at port hut nothing doing to day

146 days Remarks Monday March 9th

at 4 PM 3 boats left the ship for Port harbour for potatoes & hay & arrived on board 18 hay & 5 Boat loads of potatoes so ends this man employed as disertes
