first part
of these 24 howers strong two
reefs heeled from the E by ship
heaving by the wind to the N at
5 PM heeled ship to the S E
middle part the wind auld to
the S W latter part the same
ends the day

199 days Remarks Thursday April 30th

first part
of these 24 howers light winds
from the S W ship heading
by the wind to the S E at
4 PM & spunk the ships Drums
Barr & sabbath Drummers
middle & latter parts very
much the same employed
repeating the fore topsail so
end French rock bearing N
distance 20 miles

200 days Remarks Friday May 1st

first part
of these 24 howers light winds
& pleasant from the S W ship
heading by the wind to the W
at 4 PM heeled ship to the S E middle
& latter parts very much the same
the rainbow & sabbath Drummers
in sight on the weather beam

Master Cruising off French Rock

201 days Remarks Saturday May 2nd

first part
of these 24 howers strong winds
& squall from the E by ship
heaving by the wind to the
S E at 12 PM heeled ship
to the N at 1 PM shortened sail
French Rock in sight bearing W
distance 20 miles middle part the
wind auld to the N & coming
blowing on latter part at 10 PM
took in the fore topsail & went
ship so ends this day

202 days Remarks Sunday May 3rd

first part
of these 24 howers strong gale
from the N ship heading by
the wind to the E by E at
4 M closed reef the main topsail
& furled the fore sail & hove
the ship too middle part
more moderate latter part
at 6 PM set the fore sail
& two reef fore topsail
so end French rock bearing W by W

203 days Remarks Monday May 4th

first part
of these 24 howers strong winds
from the E by ship
heaving to the E at 4 AM
set the fore & spunked middle
& latter parts very fine tearing
we find that we have
a strong current seting to the S E
employed rattling belain fore topsail
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
