204 days Remarks Tuesday May 5th

first part of these 24 hours light winds to pleasant from the S.E. steering W.W. middle part the same latter part at 7 PM veered ship to the S.W. employed rattling down curtains & racks in sight bearing W by N distance 10 miles

205 days Remarks Wednesday May 6th

first part of these 24 hours strong winds from the S.E. ship heaving by the wind to the N.W. at 5 AM saw a school of sperm whales going quick to windward lowered the sails & the sails mild off going very quick to leeward chist on till dark but no success a very small charr so near night middle part veered ship to the S.E. latter part at 6 AM commencing raining all the rest part of the day caught 15 blbs of water & ends

206 days Remarks Thursday May 7th

first part of these 24 hours light winds & plenty of rain at 5 AM veered the fore topmast ship heading S by E middle & latter parts very much the same so ends the day

207 days Remarks Friday May 8th

first part of these 24 hours light winds & calm with rain to day the Capt Macy chestised the cook for not tending to his duty middle & latter part very much the same so ends the day

208 days Remarks Saturday May 9th

first part of these 24 hours light winds from the S.E. steering W.W. at 5 AM took in the light sails middle part plenty of rain latter part more fine at 4 PM made sail & steered off W.W. as so ends the day

209 days Remarks Sunday May 10th

first part of these 24 hours light winds & calms from the W steering N Sunday Island in sight bearing W.W. distance 40 miles also one sail in sight of weather beam middle part the same latter part at 9 PM past close to Sunday Island saw the Rainbow & supplied Stanton ends in a boat so ends the day

210 days Remarks Monday May 11th

first part of these 24 hours light winds & calms from the S.E. steering N at 4 AM spoke the B.B. & S.T. middle & latter parts very much the same so ends

211 days Remarks Tuesday May 12th

first part of these 24 hours calm sunny S.E. in sight bearing E.S. distance 20 miles middle & latter parts very much the same employed on ship duty Sunday Island in sight bearing S by E distance 35 miles
