first part of these 24 hawsers light winds & variable from the N.W. ship heading by the wind to the S.W. middle part the wind auld to the S. latter part auld to the N.W. with rain, employed putting a cross tree to the mission so ends the day

234 days Remarks Thursday June 3rd

first part of these 24 hawsers light winds from the W. steering up by 6 with all sail cut bound to the S. middle part the wind auld to the S. latter part the wind auld to the S. very light with a heavy swell from the S. so ends the day
