Saturday June 20th at 8 AM
came to in 10 fathoms calay bottom.
all this day employed breaking out
rafting chaps at 2 PM sent in
a raft of 60 bbls employed the
rest part of day cleaning up the ship

260 days Remarks Sunday June 21st
nothing
during the day at 9 AM the a
chain of fire was given from
forward ignited all hands up
& cannon bearing water & soon
found me ad put that out found
that same one of the man
ad taking some all hard working
& set light to that ad got under
strong heat way when discovered
so ends this day

261 days Remarks Monday June 28th
at 11 AM cannon breaking
out the meat to coopers employed
all day but did not get through
to clear the ship. Gerdemacy horse
in flight capt. Macy & capt. Michaels
went on board at 6 PM caught all
hands a raft to find out who
set the ship on fire last night.
Questioned all hands a boat that
all gave satisfactory answers.
but 3 William Thompson Thomas Williams
& Theodore put all 3 in irons
to night & to be kept at work in the
day so ends this day

262 days Remarks Tuesday June 24th
employed
coopering meat & turning water in
board received 28 fathoms so ends the
day

263 days Remarks Wednesday June 30th
employed
setting up shack & getting ready to
stom water at 10 AM sent in a raft at
& took off a raft of 60 bbls of water
so ends the day

264 days Remarks Thursday July 2nd
first part
employed stowing down water &
mound out 1 AM sent in a raft
& cannon fitting head gear so ends

265 days Remarks Friday July 3rd
at 5 AM
sent in the boats from a raft
at 11 sent in a natter raft to get
light the rest part of day employed fitting
head gear to the received on board
12 bunches of kangas 3 men still
in irons at night but taking out
in the day time

266 days Remarks Saturday July 4th
employed
taking in water & stowing down
so ends the day
