267 days. Remarks Sunday July 5th
all hands
on board doing nothing

268 days. Remarks Monday July 6th
at 7 AM
stowing away water & wood
so ends this day

269 days. Remarks Tuesday July 7th
all hands employed setting up head gear
to clear the ship Daniel Wood arrived
nothing since leaving the bay

270 days. Remarks Wednesday July 8th
at 5 PM
received on board 30 bags & some yarns
so ends this day

271 days. Remarks Thursday July 9th
to day
employed painting & boats &c

272 days. Remarks Friday July 10th
nothing doing

273 days. Remarks Saturday July 11th
at 7 AM got on the way with
the Rainbow & Daniel Wood at
2 PM came to anchor in 6 fathoms
of water under the lee side of
Maucha Island to get coconuts
the natives employed collecting them

274 days. Remarks Sunday July 12th
nothing doing
to day

275 days. Remarks Monday July 13th
at 7 AM received from
the natives 2500 coconuts
5 AM received 20 baskets of potatoes
so ends expecting to sail tomorrow

276 days. Remarks Tuesday July 14th
at 6 AM could not all hands to get on the
way found after all hands were
instructed that one man was missing
by the name of
& reported to the Capt. where on
the captain ordered the Officer 2. Keers of
poppers & two muskets at 10 AM caught
him took him on board & paid
anchor in company with the ships
Rainbow & Daniel Wood sent the
disaster in cross

277 days. Remarks Wednesday July 15th
first part
of there, a heavy strong wind from
the E ship heading off shore we beat
the chains & stowed the anchors getting
with the S. B. muddles & latter parts
very much the same so ends
the day
