first part of these 24 hours strong winds from the S. E. ship heading N. E. by W middle part the same latter part at 5 P.M. veered ship to the S. & got into the reef & steered off at 11 employed fitting the rig so ends this hard day

304 days Remarks Tuesday Aug 11th
first part strong winds from the S. E. ship heading a long the reef at 4 veered ship to the N. E. & shortened sail middle & latter parts very much the same employed fitting the job & flying jib guys ends the day

305 days Remarks Wednesday Aug 12th
first part light winds from the S. E. ship heading along the reef at 5 P.M. veered ship heading N. E. by W middle & latter parts very much the same so ends this day

306 days Remarks Thursday Aug 13th
first part of these 24 hours light winds from the S. E. ship heading N. E. by W middle part the same latter part at 9 P.M. put spunk the ship. Rain here so ends this day

first part light winds from the S. E. ship heading by the wind to the E. Round Island in sight bearing S. by E distance 20 miles middle & latter parts very much the same so ends the day

308 days Remarks Saturday Aug 15th
first part strong winds from the S. E. ship heading N. E. with the sowers in sight middle part ~~steered~~ the same latter part at 5 P.M. veered ship & steered off for Bevers Island at 8 veered the day

309 days Remarks Sunday Aug 16th
first part of these 24 hours strong winds & very rough steering S. W. at 6 will lift too heading off shore at 5 P.M. veered ship after veering ship Thomas Williams got on the lower head boat to all in the spunker raving the raving parted & he fell off the Boat striking his head on the rail & then fell overboard all a back & lowered a boat but saw him no more so passed. he broke his neck at 12 saw Bevers Island bearing S. by E distance 15 miles so ends the day
