351st day Remarks Tuesday October 6th

first part

at 11 PM saw Choctawhatchee bearing
E by S steared off for Port Harbort in to
Anchor ends

362nd day Remarks Wednesday October 7th

first part
of these 24 hours strong wind from
the N by ship heading for Port Harbort
at 4 PM came to Anchor in 10 fathoms
of water middle & latter part very much
the same so ends the day

363rd day Remarks Thursday Oct 8th

first part
employed getting water off. Latter
part got off 20 bbls so ends the day

364th day Remarks Friday Oct 9th

first part
employed staving water got off
30 bbls more. Latter part the same
so ends the day

365th day Remarks Saturday Oct 10th

first part
is a thick fog & nothing doing
middle & Latter part the same
so ends the day

Master *Leaving* In Port Harbort

366th day Remarks Sunday Oct 11th

first part
thick weather & rain at 2 PM
Received on board one ox brought
from shore middle & latter part nothing
doing so ends the day

367th day Remarks Monday Oct 12th

first part
of these 24 hours light winds from the
S by W at 2 PM the capt. went to Port Harbort
to get potatoes at 6 PM got back with
12 kitts middle part nothing doing. Latter
part the capt. went to Port Harbort for more
potatoes so ends

368th day Remarks Tuesday Oct 13th

first part
of these 24 hours received on board 2 Boat
loads of potatoes. Latter part at 4 PM
got on the way & stood out to sea
stowed the anchors & on board the chains
so ends this day

369th day Remarks Wednesday Oct 14th

first part
of these 24 hours light winds from
the W with rain at 4 PM saw the
Pearmaid bearing S by E distance 25 miles
more we are going to cruise middle
& latter parts the same so ends the
day
