404th day Remarks Saturday Nov 20th

first part of these 24 hours strong gale from the W. ship lying two heading to the S.W. at 4 more moderate set the fore staysail at 7 set the fore topmast cleft reef middle part more moderate latter part at 7 set the mainmast jib & 1 further rounds land in sight bearing N.W. by N distance 30 miles

405th day Remarks Sunday Nov 21st

first part strong winds & squalls from the W. ship heading to the S.W. middle & latter parts very much the same so ends the day

406th day Remarks Monday Nov 22nd

first part of these 24 hours strong winds from the S.E. ship heading to the W. at 7 P.M. shortened sail middle & latter parts whole topmast breezes so ends the day

407th day Remarks Tuesday Nov 23rd

first part of these 24 hours strong two reef breezes from the S.E. ship heading to the W. middle part it backed up from the S. & blowed on to a moderate gale latter part fresh the fore topmast & foremast cleft reef the main yards the John Wells in sight have two to mindward

Master Cruising off The Permid

408th day Remarks Wednesday Nov 24th

first part of these 24 hours strong gale from the S.E. ship have two to the S.W. middle part more moderate wind ship & set the fore sail latter part more moderate made sail on the ship at 11 P.M. saw the Permid bearing N.W. distance 20 miles so ends

409th day Remarks Thursday Nov 25th

first part of these 24 hours strong two reef breezes from the S.E. ship heading to the W. middle & latter parts very much the same so ends the day

410th day Remarks Friday Nov 26th

first part of these 24 hours strong two reef breezes from the S.E. ship at 3 P.M. corner moderating middle part the same latter part at 5 made sail so ends with the John Wells in sight

411th day Remarks Saturday Nov 27th

first part of these 24 hours strong two reef breezes from the S.E. ship heading to the W. at 5 saw the John Wells take two black jacks middle part the same latter part at 7 P.M. spake the ship Daniel Wood 1150 spars & 300 of whale so ends the day bark John Wells in sight in our weather here
