1st day Remarks Monday December 28th
first part of these 24 hours strong winds & very rough from the ESE the ship heading off & over the pinnid middle & latter parts very much the same so ends the day

2nd day Remarks Tuesday December 29th
first part of these 24 hours light winds & rainy from the WNW ship heading to the W at 2 PM spoke the Daniel Wood & Stephenra middle part the same latter part at 4 AM on bent the foresail to reefed saw black fish landed but could not get part so ends the day

3rd day Remarks Wednesday Dec 30th
first part of these 24 hours light winds from the W ship heading to the NW middle part the same latter part at 4 AM stood off for St. Peter's Island to get a raft of water at 10 sent in a raft of 60 lbs at 3 so ends the day

4th day Remarks Thursday Dec 31st
first part of these 24 hours strong winds from the SE ship lying off & on at hanks place at 3 PM in the raft. & stood out south of the pinnid middle part the same latter part comm. staying down the water so ends the day

Master Cruising off The Pinnid

1st day Remarks Friday January 1st 1864
first part of these 24 hours light winds from the W ship heading to the W at 3 PM got through staying down at 6 PM spoke the Bird's Hornery & put on Board the bay lumber for misconduct in a previous date with the cook to be forwarded home to his Parents middle & latter parts fine so ends the day

2nd day Remarks Saturday Jan 2nd
first part of these 24 hours light winds & pleasant from the W ship heading to the SE middle part the same latter part at 6 AM veered ship to the N & made sail so ends the day

3rd day Remarks Sunday Jan 3rd
first part of these 24 hours light winds from the WNW ship heading to the SE at 7 PM took in sail & veered ship to the N middle part the same latter part at 4 AM made all sail & veered ship so ends the day with a 10 sail in sight

4th day Remarks Monday Jan 4th
first part of these 24 hours light winds & thick from the W ship heading to the SE middle part it crossed on latter part the same took in the foresail & light so ends the day
