455th Remarks *Wednesday January 13th*
 first part of these 24 hours strong winds from the N ship heading to the ESE middle part the same latter part heading to the WNW so ends the day employed repairing the mainsail

456th Remarks *Thursday Jan 14th*
 first part of these 24 hours light winds from the N ship heading to the ESE at 4 noon ship spoke the larboard mast middle & latter part foggy so ends the day

457th Remarks *Friday January 15th*
 first part of these 24 hours light winds & thick from the N ship heading to the ESE at 7 noon ship to the WNW middle & latter part the same so ends the day

458th Remarks *Saturday January 16th*
 first part of these 24 hours light winds from the N ship heading to the WNW under short sail middle part the same latter part at 5 AM made all sail at 10 AM it comm. blowing on took in all the light sails & took reef the topsails at 11 AM split the gill very bad furl'd the mainsail & fore topsail & spanker at 12 noon moderate so ends the day

459th Remarks *Sunday January 17th*
 first part of these 24 hours strong winds from the N ship heading to the WSW at 4 the wind veered to the W weerd ship & set the fore topsail at 15 bent a new main hatter jib middle & latter part minus from the N weerd the ship close up to the Bermid but saw nothing so ends the day

460th Remarks *Monday January 18th*
 first part of these 24 hours strong winds from the N ship heading WSW at 7 noon ship & took in sail permaid bearing N distance 10 miles middle & latter part very much the same so ends the permaid bearing N distance 10 miles

461th Remarks *Tuesday Jan 19th*
 first part of these 24 hours light winds from the N ship heading to the ESE middle & latter part heading to the WNW so ends the day permaid bearing N

462th Remarks *Wednesday Jan 20th*
 first part of these 24 hours light winds from the N ship heading to the ESE middle & latter part the same so ends the day

463th Remarks *Thursday Jan 21st*
 first part of these 24 hours light winds from the N ship at 7 spoke the larboard mast & exchanged a cable with her middle & latter part the same so ends the day
