500 days Remarks Saturday Feb 27th
first part
employed scrapping ship & Boating off
potatoes at 5. Received 20 kits more
latter part the same so ends the day

501 days Remarks Sunday Feb 28th
laying in
Port but starboard with 1 shore on
liberty latter part employed getting off
water & scrapping ship so ends this day

502 days Remarks Monday March 1st
first part
employed stowing water & scrapping ship
& painting latter part employed getting off
water & painting ship so ends the day

503 days Remarks Tuesday March 2nd
first employed
painting ship & stowing water
latter part the same so ends the day

504 days Remarks Wednesday Mar 3rd
first part of
there 24 hammers employed painting ship
latter part the same to day the
captain started for Boat Harbour
but found it so rugged to ad to give it
up

first part
strong winds from the S.W. starboard
watch shore on liberty latter part
at 6 AM the Capt started for Boat Harbour
for potatoes received on board to
day 6 tons more order so ends the day

506 days Remarks Friday March 4th
first part employed
Boating off potatoes & painting ship
latter part the same so ends by receiving
on board two Boats laded with
onions & 1 of potatoes in all about
ten tons

507 days Remarks Saturday March 5th
first part
employed painting ship latter part at
7 AM the Capt started for Boat Harbour
for bags with one Boat & then went
on shore with the rest of the crew to
cut wood got off in Boat ladder & found
that one man was missing by the name
of Elias Howard tried to find him but could
not meet off & got ready for sea so
ends with one Boat steered off duty sick

508 days Remarks Sunday March 6th
first part of
there 24 hammers light winds from the S.W.
at 2 PM the Capt came on board to sail
beginning with him 9 days & 7 kits of iron
at 3 got on the way under all sail
latter part steering S.W. at 12 passed the
Daniel Wood & Alabama so ends the day
