533^{days} Remarks Thursday March 31st

first part of these 24 hours strong winds from the E & S the ship heading to the S middle part the same latter part at 5 AM used ship & sent down the fore sail to be repaired & ends this day in steering off for the Alabama

534^{days} Remarks Friday April 1st

first part of these 24 hours strong winds from the E & S a ship heading to the N at 4 PM speak the Alabama & received our share of the whale 128 gallons middle part heading to the S latter part used ship to the N latter part the same ship under short sail French Rock bearing N & distance 10 miles

535^{days} Remarks Saturday April 2nd

first part of these 24 hours strong winds from the E & S ship heading to the S at 1 PM used ship to the N in company with the Alabama & Sarskute latter part the same used French Rock bearing N & distance 2 miles

536^{days} Remarks Sunday April 3rd

first part light winds from the E & S ship heading to the S wind to the S under whale topails manruit, jib & spanker carried them all night latter part the same French Rock bearing N & distance 5 miles

537^{days} Remarks Monday April 4th

first part very light winds from the E & S ship heading to the S at 6 PM shortened sail middle part the wind shifted to the S latter part at 2 AM saw a school of sperm whales going quick to windward toward & chased all day but no success French Rock in sight bearing N & distance 20 miles

538^{days} Remarks Tuesday April 5th

first part strong winds from the E & S ship heading to the S at 1 PM used ship to the S latter part at 5 AM used ship to the N under two reefs employed repairing the fore sail & ends the day

539^{days} Remarks Wednesday April 6th

first part light winds & variable from the E & S ship heading to the S middle part the same latter part at 5 AM used ship to the N wind shifted to the E & S bent the fore sail & sent down the main top sail to repair & at 11 AM bent that again & sent two sail in sight rock bearing N & distance 15 miles

light winds from the E & S ship heading to the S middle & latter parts calmed employed scraping the chains plates
