 weather more moderate at 6 weerd ship
 to the E S E the wind coming to the S
 & fine ship heading E S E Baker & Williams
 still confined

568 day Remarks Sunday May 8th
 first part
 light winds & very squally from the S
 ship heading to the E S E at 5 PM
 saw french Rock bearing N E distance
 15 miles middle part the same
 latter part at 10 M spoke the
 Alabama ship heading to the S

569 day Remarks Monday May 9th
 first part
 strong winds & squally from the S W
 ship heading to the S bound to
 the Bay of Islands in company with
 the Ark middle & latter part very squally
 parted the jib spanker mainsail &
 foresail so ends the day Baker & Williams
 still confined

 first part
 strong winds & very squally from the
 W ship heading S by W middle &
 latter part the same so ends the day

571 day Remarks Wednesday May 11th
 first part
 strong winds & squally from the S W
 ship heading the S at 1 M saw
 the Alabama with colors to the fore
 weerd ship & found that he cut sea
 braces to the windward middle &
 latter part calm so ends Baker & Williams
 still in confinement

572 day Remarks Thursday May 12th
 first part
 light winds from the N W ship heading
 for course S W with all sail out bound
 to the Bay middle part the same latter
 part at 4 M comm backing on took in
 sail down to two reefs & courses at 10 M
 parted the courses jib & spanker & at 12 M
 reef the main topsail hauled the fore & here
 has two so ends the day

573 day Remarks Friday May 13th
 first part
 gales from the N W ship bore two heading
 W S W at 6 PM the wind wild to
 the S very light made all sail on the
 ship middle & latter part calm
 so ends the day
