576 dyp Remarks Monday May 16<sup>th</sup>  
first part  
light winds from the S ship heading  
SSE under all sail middle part let  
comer breezing on from the WSW  
latter part took in the light sails  
furled the mainsail jib & spanker too  
reft the fore & main topmasts so ends  
the day

577 dyp Remarks Tuesday May 17<sup>th</sup>  
first part  
strong gale from the NWS ship  
running under a two reef main & fore  
topmasts stay sail at 4 PM cald  
to & close reef the main topmasts middle  
part it blowed on to a heavy gale ship  
making very good weather but it the  
day took like a duck  
Lat 35. 05 S  
Long 175. 51 E

578 dyp Remarks Wednesday May 18<sup>th</sup>  
first part  
more moderate set the foremast fore  
topmasts mainsail jib & spanker ship  
heading SSE distant from the SW  
middle part the same latter part  
it blowed on from the SSW ship  
heading to the SSE to day Robert Taylor  
was taking out of irons the foremast  
never to due the like again so ends the day  
Lat 35. 23  
Long 175. 44

579 dyp Remarks Thursday May 19<sup>th</sup>  
first part  
strong gale from the WSW ship heading  
to the EWS middle part more moderate  
made sail at 1 PM veer ship to the  
S latter part the same employed repairing  
the fore topmast so ends the day

580 dyp Remarks Friday May 20<sup>th</sup>  
first part  
strong winds from the SSW ship heading  
to the NWS with all sail out  
middle part the wind cald from the SSW  
strong latter part the wind cald from the  
WWS ship heading SW at 10 PM the  
saw the Bear light bearing W distance  
20 miles at 11 veer ship to the WWS  
wind SWS very strong so ends the day

581 dyp Remarks Saturday May 21<sup>st</sup>  
first part  
strong winds from the SSW ship  
heading to the WWS under two reefs  
& courses middle part the same latter part  
at 6 PM veer ship to the S at 10 saw Cape  
& Brem bearing SW distance 25 miles  
so ends the day
