sail & stood off shore middle part the
same latter part at 5 M need ship to
the S so ends the day

639th Remarks Tuesday July 19th

first part
light winds from the S & E sailing down
along by the reef at 2 P.M. King Beretake
of mudwater come off from the
boat off some coconuts staid on board
two hammers & iron left middle part
ship heading to the N.E. latter part
at 3 M need ship to the S employed
painting the spars so ends the day

642th Remarks Friday July 22th

first part

to the S at 12 P.M. received from the
sloop George 700 yards some coco nuts & c
middle & latter parts calm

643th Remarks Saturday July 23th

first part
light winds from the S & E
ship heading to the S at 12 M need
ship to the S.W. middle part the same
latter part stood in to the reef &
steamed off S.W. employed clearing ship
getting ready to paint so ends the day

644th Remarks Sunday July 24th

first part
light winds from the S & E ship heading
to the S middle & latter parts calm
so ends the day
