mate went ashore again and was treated well and in the After
noon Eight Portuge Gentlemen came off with the Capt
and Bought a Cheese and were to Pay for it in wine and
the Capt and mate and William Green with a boat came
ashore from to get the pay and was treated very well
with wine but when they would come on board the Portuges took
the Capt and said he must go to Gale but Green
run down to the boat that Lay off & clear of the Star
board boat and said hand a Lane, which we did and Run up for to clear
the Capt and mate but they fought their way through and Com
to the Boat but they took Green and put him in Gale
and followed the Capt & mate to the boat but
kitch them and have of S. Lane at the boat but

Tuesday 31st Small wind and variable Lay at Anchor in Virge
Harber, in the Afternoon a boat Com on board of us with an
officer, and said for the Capt would pay 24 Dollars they
would send Green on board of us and the 17 Gallons of wine
the Lane and car which we left the day before, So he would be
right but the green nothing else was sent on board

Wednesday June 1st Wind Variable and some Rain at night
Came off a boat and Brought the Cag of wine that was
Left a shore and a Letter from Green, and Samples
Which we bought of them and they said they would send
off Green next Day. So Ends this day with nothing
Remarable

Thursday 2nd Wind Variable, on the Afternoon the
Capt went on Shore for to know why they did not
send Green on board but they said they would send
him on board next Day. So we Com off and get
him his Jackets and some Sals, for his Head was hurt
very much with the Strokes the Portuges Give him the day before

Friday 3rd went on Shore and Green Com on board &
some Portuges and bought some Rum and in the After
noon the Capt & mate and Green went on Shore and
got some oranges and other Fruit and came on board and
At night hove up and went out of the Harber

Saturday 4th Small wind at S.E. Run E.B.S.
See Suffer bottom all day

Sunday 5th Small wind at S.W. at 1 o'clock
See St. Nicols Baring S.E. at 12 o'clock
Went on Board of a French Brig Bound
St. Nicols & 6 days out
