Shore and Viewed their Huts and traded
With them

Sunday 26th Went on Shore and Went Back
to an other town about a mile from the first

Monday 27th Rose up and Run over to St. Jago &
Saw two Ships in the Bay then Run SE
and left at 10 o'clock to go off with the
and started for Guinea: 20 days out

Friday July 1st Wind SWSW Run SSE
Very Good Weather Lat 10-13 North

Saturday 2nd Wind SW at 10 o'clock
Saw a School of Sparrowmice and Kill
two that we Saved, and made two more Spout
Blood in the Afternoon Went to Cutting and Cut
one Body and Part of the other and heaved their heads
a way

Sunday 3rd Cut the Rest up and Begun to lay
Wind SW and Good Weather

Monday 4th Wind WSW We are a trying all Day

Tuesday 5th Wind SWSW made an End of laying
and Saved some the Cashew and Stood it away and it
made 3 Barrels

Wednesday 6th Wind all Round the Compass
and Rain Very hard Lat: 7-23 North

Thursday 7th Wind SW and Rain
and something Squally S. Ends this
all Well on Board of the Brig Polley
