Sunday 10th Wind W.B.N. and Rain
At 5 o'clock Spoke of Went on Board of a Schooner
from St. John's bound to the Island a sent on
and said that there was a Byrt Schooner
the Coast and a Man of War sent after him
He said he was in 15 West Longitude

Monday 11th Wind S.S.W. Made Sail Down
Stood to the Westward Had an Observation
and was in 17.38 North it being the first
Day for this Week past we had Clear Weather
to take the Sun

Tuesday 12th Wind S.W. Drove S.E.
At 5 o'clock See the Land Baring
S.W. Which we called Cape St. John
Sounded and had 30 fathoms Water Knocked
about And Stood to the Westward So Ends
the Day all Well on board of the Polley

Wednesday 13th Wind S.W. Stood to the
W.S.W. un bent fore top sail and Cut it
off the foot About 18 inches and Bent it
again So Ends the Day all Well on
board of the Brig Polley 9th Days out

Thursday 14th Wind S.W. at 5 o'clock in
the morning See a School of Sparmitas
and Killed one and Cut Her up So Ends
the Day Well

Friday 15th Wind S.W. Saw from the 10 Bins
of Oil and Spoke it away So Ends the Day
that the last Whale made

Saturday 16th Wind S.W. and some Rain See
a School of Blackfish but Did not Strike
Any So Ends the Day all Well on board of
the Brig Polley

Sunday 17th Wind S.W.B.W. and Good weather
Lay by all Day

Monday 18th Wind S.W. and Good weather
See a School of Blackfish

Tuesday 19th Wind Variable and Rain in the
first Part of the day in the latter Part
fine Weather the Wind S.W.

Wednesday 20th Wind S.W. and Rain
So Nothing Remarkable this Day

Thursday 21st Wind S.S.W. fresh Breeze
and Rain So Ends the Day all well
on board of the Brig Polley

Friday 22nd Wind S.W. and Very Rainy
and some Rain for it has not forgotten
Lay by all Day Stove Saw 4
