

Saturday October 8th Wind S.W.
Rain W.W. had some rain and great
Wind Lat 53 2 ^{some from confusion and out on to make} and sea rough again

Sunday 9th Wind S.W. faster Wind
with Rain and a long sea so ended the
Day on board of the Good Brig Polley
^{now we are about 100 miles of sailing from Cape of Good Hope}

Monday 10th fine Wether Wind small &
Variable mended main sail so nothing reman-
able on board of the Brig Polley

Tuesday 11th fine Wether etc. we look in the
morning began to make up the hole the carbon
sides & gave the Brig a Starboard heave &
sweep the starboard side at 12 o'clock we
saw a school of Whales and killed two and got them
a couple of hundred then went to work & started
a fifty gallons & a thirty gallons of water
and filled them with oil & worked the
Whale again & finished at one o'clock in the morning

Wednesday 12th Cat up the top Whales we had
the Day before & began to top ^{the whales} had some rain

Thursday 13th fine Wether the first
part of the Day see Whales & chased
them but could not strike them in the
After noon had a squall put out the fire

Friday 14th fine Wether all Day finished
trying and sandrove the oil and stored it a-
way and it made 30 Barrels see Whales
very plenty but a great way off. See
Cape of Good Hope in the Day on board of the
Good Brig Polley with 175 Barrels of oil
on board 184 Days from Nantucket

Saturday 15th October See Whales in the
morning hove out the Boats & chased them
but it being so squally we did not strike
so we came back and it rained & rain hard the
Wind about East we were about 8 miles from
the Vessel when the Squall took us

Sunday 16th fine Wether the Wind small
And at 5 P.M. mended main sail Lay
tee all Day so ended the Day on board the Polley

Monday 17th small Wind & Variable with Sun
Rain covered from East Lat 6:44

Tuesday 18th fine Wether Killed one Whale
And struck 3 more & lost them so we
cut that up and began to top

Wednesday 19th finished trying fine
Wether Wind S.W. small Breeze
See plenty of Porpoises to E. end the Day

Thursday 20th had some Rain (and
Drove the oil & stored it away and it
made 30 Barrels) Wind Variable from
S.E. to S.W. See one Finback Lat 6:47

Friday 21th Good Wether but some
in the morning See two Brigs to the S.E.
but it being so calm we did not speak
with them at night lost sight of them
Lat 7:24

Saturday 22th small Wind & Variable
And very hot so nothing remarkable
this Day 192 Days from Nantucket
